



RESOLUTION FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE APPLICATION FOR A GRANT CORRESPONDING TO THE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR THE AWARDING OF GRANTS (ON THE BASIS OF COMPETITIVE TENDERING) FOR THE PUBLICATION OF CHILDREN'S AND YOUNG PEOPLE'S PICTURE BOOKS ABROAD IN 2016.

Ref. 02/ L0125 U10 DESIST- 1C_LIJ 2016

Factual Background

1. By virtue of the resolution issued by the director of the Institut Ramon Llull on 16 March 2016 (Official Gazette of the Government of Catalonia (DOGC) no. 7082 dated 18 March 2016) the application process was opened for the awarding of grants (on the basis of competitive tendering) for the publication of children's and young people's picture books abroad in 2016.
2. The applications submitted within the time limit stipulated by the application process are detailed herein.
3. The assessment committee met on 3 June 2016 to examine and nominate the applications submitted.

Legal Grounds

1. The General Grants Act (Law 38/2003 of 17 November) and Royal Decree 887/2006 of 21 July approving the Regulations for said Act.
2. Legislative Decree 3/2002 of 24 December approving the revised text of the Public Finance Act of Catalonia.
3. Government Agreement 110/2014 of 22 July approving the model of regulatory rules for procedures regarding grants awarded on the basis of competitive tendering, as processed by the administration of the Government of Catalonia and the corresponding public sector bodies.
4. Article 90 of the Legal Framework for Public Administrations and Common Administrative Procedure Act (Law 30/1992, of 26 November), states that anybody may withdraw their application, or surrender their rights where legally permitted to do so.
5. Rule 12.4 of the rules governing the application process for the awarding of grants by the Institut Ramon Llull for activities involving the publication abroad of illustrated children's and young people's literature in 2016, regulates that anybody may withdraw their grant application in writing, prior to its awarding, upon acceptance by the issuing body.

In accordance with the assessment committee's report and rule 12.3 of the rules governing the application process, it is established that it falls upon the examining body to reach a decision regarding the withdrawal of the submitted applications,

Accordingly, I resolve

To accept the withdrawal and I declare the grant application listed in the Annex as closed.

Admissible Appeals

This resolution does not exhaust the administrative channels for appeal and in accordance with Articles 114 and 115 of the Legal Framework for Public Administrations and Common Administrative Procedure Act (Law 30/1992 of 26 November) and Article 18.1 of the Statutes of the Institut Ramon Llull, an appeal for the matter to be passed to a higher authority may be lodged with the Director of the Institut Ramon Llull within a period of one month following publication of this resolution.
