

RESOLUTION DECIDING ON THE WITHDRAWN GRANT APPLICATIONS FROM THE SECOND CALL TO PUBLISH ILLUSTRATED WORKS ABROAD

Acts

- 1. By resolution of the Director of the Institut Ramon Llull Consortium (hereinafter, the "Institut Ramon Llull") dated 11 April 2024 (DOGC no. 9148, of 23 April 2024) concerning the second call 2024 for the awarding of grants on a competitive basis to publish illustrated works abroad (ref. BDNS 754487).
- 2. By resolution of the Director of the Institut Ramon Llull dated 18 July 2024 (DOGC no. 9213, of 26 July 2024), which amends the budget allocation concerning the second call 2024 for the awarding of grants on a competitive basis to publish illustrated works abroad (ref. BDNS 754487).
- 3. Applications submitted by the deadline specified in the call are included in the file.
- The evaluation committee met on 11 July 2024 to analyse and evaluate the applications submitted.

Legal bases

- 1. Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on General Subsidies, and Royal Decree 887/2006, of 21 July, approving the Regulations of Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on General Subsidies.
- 2. Legislative Decree 3/2002, of 24 December, approving the revised text of the Public Finance Act of Catalonia.
- 3. Government Agreement GOV/85/2016, of 28 June, approving the amendment of the standard form of regulatory bases approved by Agreement GOV/110/2014, of 22 July, approving the standard form of regulatory bases for the procedures of the awarding of grants on a competitive basis, processed by the Administration of the Generalitat (Government of Catalonia) and its public sector, and approving the full text.
- 4. Resolution of 17 January 2024 (DOGC no. 9085, of 23 January 2024) announcing an agreement by the Board of Directors on 21 December 2023 amending the terms and conditions that must govern the awarding of grants to publish illustrated works abroad.
- 5. Articles 21, 94.1 and 94.4 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, on the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administration.
- 6. Section 12, governing the awarding of grants by the Institut Ramon Llull on residencies for translators of literary works in Catalan and Aranese, regulates rejected and withdrawn applications.
- 7. Point 12.3 of the terms and conditions states that it is up to the examining body to decide on rejected and withdrawn applications that are submitted.
- 8. Point 12.4 of the aforementioned terms and conditions states that, without prejudice to the withdrawal provided for in point 11.4, any applicant may withdraw their grant application in writing before the grant is awarded and that the examining body must accept this withdrawal.



I hereby resolve to

- Accept the withdrawal and declare the grant procedure closed for the applications listed in Annex.

Lawful appeals

This resolution, which does not exhaust the administrative channels, as per articles 121 and 122 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administration, may be appealed and any such appeals must be lodged with the Director of the Institut Ramon Llull within one month of the day following the publication of this resolution. The one-month term ends on the same date the resolution was published.
