

RESOLUTION RESOLVING TO REJECT APPLICATIONS IN THE SECOND 2025 CALL TO AWARD GRANTS TO PUBLISH ILLUSTRATED WORKS IN FOREIGN MARKETS

Ref. 02/ L0124 U10 PROMOCIÓ_INADM (2a C)

RECITALS

1. Resolution of the director of the Consortium of the Institut Ramon Llull (hereinafter Institut Ramon Llull), dated 6 May 2025 (DOGC number 9409 of 9 May 2025) opened the second 2025 call to award grants, on a competitive basis, to publish illustrated works in foreign markets.
2. Resolution of the director of Institut Ramon Llull (hereinafter Institut Ramon Llull), dated 21 July 2025 (DOGC number 9462 of 25 July 2025), modified the budget earmarked for the second 2025 call to award grants, on a competitive basis, to publish illustrated works in foreign markets.
3. The applications submitted by the deadline established in the call are listed in the file.
4. On 17 July 2025, the assessment committee met to analyse and assess the applications submitted.

Legal basis

1. Law 38/2003, of 17 November (General Subsidies Act), and Royal Decree 887/2006, of 21 July, approving the Regulation of Law 38/2003, of 17 November (General Subsidies Act).
2. Royal Legislative Decree 3/2002, of 24 December, approving the revised text of Public Finance Act of Catalonia.
3. Agreement GOV/85/2016 of 28 June, which approves the modification of the type of regulatory rules approved by the Agreement GOV/110/2014 of 22 July, by which the types of regulatory rules of the procedures for the granting of subsidies under competitive competition, processed by the Administration of the Catalan Government and its public sector, are approved.
4. Resolution dated 22 January 2025 (DOGC number 9337, of 27 January 2025) announcing the agreements of the Board of Directors dated 16 January 2025 modifying the guidelines governing the awarding of grants for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature abroad.
5. Articles 21, 94.1 and 94.4 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on Common Administrative procedure of public administrations.
6. Point 12 of the guidelines governing the awarding of grants by Institut Ramon Llull for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature abroad deals with rejection and withdrawal of applications.
7. Point 12.3 of the guidelines governing this call provides that it is the task of the examining body to issue resolutions rejecting or withdrawing applications.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

- The applications listed in the annex be rejected.

Lawful appeals

This resolution, which does not exhaust the administrative channels, as per articles 121 and 122 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administration, and article 19 of the Institut Ramon Llull bylaws, may be appealed and any such appeals must be lodged with the Institut Ramon Llull management within one month of the day following notification of this resolution.

In this case, the applicant expects to publish the work in July 2025 and the final resolution of this call is expected for late September 2025. The work will be published before the grant is awarded.

The committee proposes to reject the grant application submitted by Efstratios Prousalis to publish the work *Un niño muy raro* in Greek, written by Ricardo Alcántara and illustrated by Albert Asensio, because it does not comply with point 2.1 of the guidelines governing this call.

Point 2.1 establishes that publishers (self-employed individuals or legal entities, public or private, Spanish or foreign) that have planned to publish or jointly publish illustrated works illustrated by an individual who resides in Catalonia or the Balearic Islands are eligible for these grants. In this case, the applicant Efstratios Prousalis submitted an application as an individual, not a publisher, as the application was submitted on behalf of an individual and not a legal entity.

Therefore, the examining body rejects this application.
