

RESOLUTION THE AWARDING OF GRANTS, ON A COMPETITIVE BASIS, FOR THE SECOND 2025 CALL FOR ACTIVITIES AIMED AT PROMOTING CATALAN AND ARANESE LITERATURE ABROAD

L0124 U10 Resol def. 2aC 2025

Facts

1. Resolution of the director of Consorci Institut Ramon Llull (hereinafter Institut Ramon Llull), dated 4 June 2025 (DOGC number 9431, of 11 June 2025) opened the second call to award grants, on a competitive basis, for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature abroad.
2. The applications submitted by the deadline established in the call are listed in the file.
3. On 27 October 2025, the assessment committee met to analyse and assess the applications submitted.
4. On 25 November 2025, the examining body issued a provisional resolution proposal for the awarding of grants, based on the recommendations of the assessment committee.
5. On 11 December 2025 the examining body issued a resolution proposal for the awarding of grants, based on the assessment committee proposal.

Legal grounds

1. Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on General Subsidies, and Royal Decree 887/2006, of 21 July, approving the Regulation of Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on General Subsidies.
2. Legislative Decree 3/2002, of 24 December, approving the Revised Text of the Law on Public Finances of Catalonia.
3. The Decision dated 22 January 2025 (DOGC no. 9337, of 27 January 2025) publicising the Agreement of the Board of Directors dated 16 January 2025 amending the guidelines governing the awarding of grants for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature abroad.
4. Rule 10 of the guidelines governing the awarding of grants for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature abroad regulates the procedure for awarding grants.
5. Point 10.1 of said guidelines establishes that the procedure for the granting of subsidies is being processed under competitive competition.
6. Point 10.3 of the aforementioned guidelines establishes that applications are analysed by an assessment committee whose composition is determined in the guidelines themselves. The members of the evaluation committee are appointed by decision of the Director of the Consorci Institut Ramon Llull.
7. Point 13.1 establishes that the person holding the Management position of the Institut Ramon Llull will resolve within a maximum period of six months from the date of publication of the call.
8. Point 1.3 states that grants awarded in accordance with these guidelines are considered de minimis aid, governed by Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/2831 of 13 December 2023 on the application of Articles 107 and 108 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union to de minimis aid (OJ L2023/2831, de 15.12.2023).

9. Point 13.2 establishes that the resolution will expressly state that the award is a de minimis grant.

10. Institut Ramon Llull has earmarked funds in this year's budget to cover the grants awarded herein.

Article 13.2 e) of the Institut Ramon Llull bylaws grants the person holding the Management position the power to resolve issues of grants.

Decision

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

1. Grants be awarded for the purpose and amounts to the entities listed in the Annex.
2. Payment of 100% shall be processed once all the supporting documents for the grant-funded activity and the expenditure incurred have been submitted, as per the terms in the point 16 of the guidelines governing this call.
3. These grants shall be considered de minimis grants, governed by Commission Regulation (EU) 2023/2831 of 13 December 2023 on the application of Articles 107 and 108 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union to de minimis aid (OJ L2023/2831, de 15.12.2023).
4. The recipients of the grants must undertake to provide any information requested regarding the grant awarded, at all times, and submit to any reviews or monitoring that Institut Ramon Llull or other competent bodies deem necessary.

Lawful appeals

This resolution, which does not exhaust the administrative channels, as per articles 121 and 122 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administration, may be appealed and any such appeals must be lodged with the President of the Institut Ramon Llull Board of Directors within one month of the day following publication of this resolution.
