

RESOLUTION FOR WHICH THE RESOLUTION ON THE 2020 CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE AWARDING OF GRANTS, THROUGH A COMPETITIVE TENDER, FOR PUBLICATION OF ILLUSTRATED WORKS ABROAD, IS MODIFIED

Ref. 02/ L0125 U10_OBRES IL-LUSTRADES_RES_DEF_MODIF

Background facts

1. A decision was taken by the director of Consorci de l'Institut Ramon Llull (referred to below as the Ramon Llull Institute) on 9 January 2020 (DOGC [Official Catalan Government Gazette] no. 8047 of 22 January 2020), modified by the decision of 10 July 2020 (DOGC no. 8179 of 17 July 2020), the 2020 call to award grants, through a competitive tender, for the publication of illustrated works abroad, is opened.
2. On 18 November 2020, the assessment committee met for analysis and proposal concerning the applications submitted.
3. On 4 December 2020, the examining body drew up the proposed provisional decision on the awarding of grants, in accordance with the assessment committee's proposal.
4. On 23 December 2020, the examining body drew up the proposed provisional decision on the awarding of grants, in accordance with the assessment committee's proposal.
5. On 23 December 2020, the director of the Institut Ramon Llull resolves the call for the granting of grants.
6. On 28 December 2020, a correction in the catalan version to the resolution of the granting of subsidies dated on 23 December 2020, is made.
7. On 27 January 2021, the director of the Institut Ramon Llull resolved to modify this call (DOGC num. 8332, of 3 February 2021).
8. The necessary funds to pay this grant will be charged to the credit in the Ramon Llull Institute's budget for the year 2020. The budgetary entry to which this credit will be applied is 010 – 103 – 410305 in the Ramon Llull Institute's budget.

Legal grounds

1. The General Subsidies Act 38/2003 of 17 November and Royal Decree 887/2006 of 21 July, approving the Regulations of the General Subsidies Act 38/2003 of 17 November.
2. Legislative Decree 3/2002 of 24 November, approving the Consolidated Text of the Catalan Public Finance Act.
3. Resolution GOV/85/2016 of 28 June, approving the modification of the standard model of the regulatory conditions approved by Resolution GOV/110/2014 of 22 July, approving the standard model of regulatory conditions for procedures to award grants through a competitive tender, processed by the Catalan Government Administration and its public sector, and approving the full text.

4. Conditions 1.2 and 13.2 of the conditions that govern the awarding of grants by the Ramon Llull Institute for the publication of illustrated works abroad.

5. The Ramon Llull Institute has adequate and sufficient funds in the current budget.

Article 13.2.e) of the Articles of Association of the Ramon Llull Institute authorises the Director of the Ramon Llull Institute to award grants.

Decision

Therefore, I decide:

1. To award the grants at the amounts and for the purpose stated to the applicants detailed in the appendix.
2. To establish that payment of 100% of the amount awarded through each of the grants be paid once the supporting documents for the funded activity have been submitted and the relevant expense has been paid in the terms stated in condition 16 of the conditions governing this call for applications. In any case, the payment shall be made in the year following the call for applications.
3. To establish that these grants are considered de minimis aid, regulated by Commission Regulation (EU) 1407/2013 of 18 December on the application of Articles 107 and 108 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union to de minimis aid (OJEU L352 of 24.12.2013).
4. To establish that the beneficiaries undertake to provide, at any time, the information requested of them concerning the grant awarded and to submit to the verification and control that the Ramon Llull Institute or other competent bodies deem necessary.

Appeals that may be lodged

This decision is not the final step in the administrative process and in accordance with articles 121 and 122 of the Common Administrative Procedure for Public Administrations Act 39/2015 of 1 October, an appeal for review may be lodged against this decision with the Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Ramon Llull Institute, within one month from the day following the date on which publication of this decision takes place. The one-month term ends on the same day on which the publication took place.
