



PROVISIONAL RESOLUTION PROPOSAL TO AWARD GRANTS ON A COMPETITIVE BASIS IN THE SECOND CALL FOR ACTIVITIES AIMED AT PROMOTING CATALAN AND ARANESE LITERATURE OUTSIDE THE CATALAN-SPEAKING AREAS

RECITALS

- 1. Resolution of the director of Consortium of the Institut Ramon Llull (hereinafter Institut Ramon Llull), dated 9 June 2023 (DOGC number 8938, of 16 June 2023) the second call was opened to award grants, on a competitive basis, for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature outside the Catalan-speaking areas (ref. BDNS 702263).
- 2. Resolution of the director of Institut Ramon Llull, dated 9 November 2023 (DOGC number 9041, of 15 November 2023) modified the budget earmarked for the first call to award grants, on a competitive basis, for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature outside the Catalan-speaking areas (ref. BDNS 702263).
- 3. The applications submitted by the deadline established in the call are listed in the file.
- 4. On 8 November 2023, the assessment committee met to analyse and assess the applications submitted.

Legal basis

- 1. Law 38/2003, of 17 November (General Subsidies Act), and Royal Decree 887/2006, of 21 July, approving the Regulation of Law 38/2003, of 17 November (General Subsidies Act).
- 2. Royal Legislative Decree 3/2002, of 24 December, approving the revised text of Public Finance Act of Catalonia.
- 3. Agreement GOV/85/2016 of 28 June, which approves the modification of the type of regulatory rules approved by the Agreement GOV/110/2014 of 22 July, by which the types of regulatory rules of the procedures for the granting of subsidies under competitive competition, processed by the Administration of the Catalan Government and its public sector, are approved.
- 4. Resolution dated 9 January 2023 (DOGC number 8832, of 13 January 2023) announcing the agreements of the Board of Directors dated 15 December 2022 modifying the guidelines governing the awarding of grants for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature abroad.
- 5. Resolution dated 4 April 2023 (DOGC number 8893, of 12 April 2023) announcing the agreements of the Board of Directors dated 31 March 2023 modifying the guidelines governing the awarding of grants for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature outside the Catalan-speaking areas.
- 6. Point 10 of the guidelines governing the awarding of grants by Institut Ramon Llull for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature abroad establishes the procedure for awarding grants.
- 7. Point 10.3 of said guidelines establishes that applications are examined by an assessment committee appointed as part of the grant call process, which will include external experts.





8. Point 10.4 of those guidelines provides that it is the task of the examining body to issue a provisional resolution proposal for the awarding of grants.

Resolution

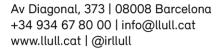
Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

- 1. The applicants listed in the annex are the proposed recipients of the grants for the amount and purpose described therein.
- 2. The applicants proposed to receive grants have 10 working days, from the day after publication of this resolution, to appeal or withdraw their applications.
- 3. The applicants proposed to receive grants in the annex shall have 10 working days from the day after publication of this resolution to submit any documents required in point 11.5 of the guidelines submitted previously that have since changed, otherwise the documents provided originally shall be taken as accurate.
- 4. If applicable, the applicants proposed to receive grants shall be required to submit any missing documents within 10 working days of the day after publication of this resolution.
- 5. Failure to submit any of the documents required within 10 working days of the day after publication of this resolution, shall be grounds for rejecting the application.
