

DECISION RESOLVING THE ABANDONMENT OF THE GRANT APPLICATION CORRESPONDING TO THE CALL FOR THE AWARDING OF GRANTS, ON A COMPETITIVE BASIS, FOR THE INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMMING OF CATALAN CREATION IN THE FIELDS OF THE VISUAL ARTS, DESIGN AND ARCHITECTURE.

BACKGROUND FACTS

- 1. By decision of the Director of the Consortium of the Institut Ramon Llull of 29 January 2024 (DOGC [Official Journal of the Government of Catalonia (*Diari Oficial de la Generalitat de Catalunya*)] number 9093, of 2 February 2024), a call for applications is hereby opened for the awarding of grants, on a competitive basis, for the international programming of Catalan artistic creation in the field of the visual arts, design and architecture (ref. BDNS 741630).
- 2. Applications submitted by the deadline established in the aforementioned call for applications are included in the dossier.
- 3. On 6 May 2024, the assessment committee met to analyse and assess the applications submitted.

LEGAL BASES

- 1. Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on general provisions for grants and subsidies, and Royal Decree 887/2006, of 21 July, approving the Regulation of Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on general provisions for grants and subsidies.
- 2. Legislative Decree 3/2002 of 24 December, approving the Consolidated Text of the Catalan Public Finance Act.
- 3. Agreement GOV/85/2016, of 28 June, approving the amendment of the standard template for governing terms and conditions approved by Agreement GOV/110/2014, of 22 July, approving the standard template for terms and conditions governing procedures for the awarding of grants, on a competitive basis, processed by the Administration of the Government of Catalonia and its public sector, and approving the full text (DOGC [Official Journal of the Government of Catalonia (*Diari Oficial de la Generalitat de Catalunya*)] no. 7152, of 30 June 2016).
- 4. The decision dated 17 January 2024 (DOGC [Journal of the Government of Catalonia (*Diari Oficial de la Generalitat de Catalunya*)] no. 9085, 23 January 2024) publicising the Decision of the Board of Directors dated 21 December 2023 approving the terms and conditions governing the awarding of grants for the international programming of Catalan artistic creation in the field of visual arts, design and architecture.
- 5. Article 94.1 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on the common administrative procedure for public administrations, establishes that any interested party may abandon their application or, when not prohibited by law, waive their rights.
- 6. Clause 12.4 states that, without prejudice to the abandonment provided for in Clause 11.4, any applicant may abandon their grant application in writing, prior to the awarding thereof, and the examining body must accept it.



DECISION

I therefore decide:

- To accept the abandonment and declare the grant application procedure detailed in the Annex concluded.

AVAILABLE APPEALS

To advise that, pursuant to Articles 121 and 122 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on the common administrative procedure of public administrations, an appeal against this decision, which does not exhaust administrative channels, may be lodged with the Director of the Consortium of the Institut Ramon Llull within a period of one month of the day following the date of notification of this resolution. The period of one month ends on the day on which the notification was made.
